Incentive to Headmasters for promotion of girls education

With a view to prevent dropouts, especially in higher standards among Adi Dravidar and Tribal girls and to increase their enrollment, a scheme of granting cash awards to encourage the Headmasters to achieve the above twin objectives, has been sanctioned by Government. The incentives in the form of cash will be given to three Headmasters who enroll and retain the largest number of Adi Dravidar / Tribal girls in Standards VI to VIII and in standards IX and X to continue till the end of the academic year in each educational district of the State through the Director of School Education.

Bright Student Award

Under this scheme two boys and two girls from each viz. Adi Dravidar, Adi Dravidar converted to Christianity and Tribal Boys and Girls who secure the highest marks in X Standard examination in each district are selected and awarded cash assistance to continue their higher studies. There is no income limit and no condition to stay in the hostel for this scheme. The awards are sanctioned at the rate of Rs.800/- per annum for the first year and Rs.960/- for the subsequent five years for a total period of six years provided if they continue their studies. The award amount is enhanced from Rs.800/- to Rs.1600/- & Rs.960/- to Rs.2000/- from the academic year 2013-14 vide G.O.Ms.No.89, AD & TW (ADW.3) Dept, Dated. 22.10.2013 and Govt Lr. No. 20166/ADW-3/2013-1, Dated. 10.01.2014. During 2013-2014, 244 students were benefited at a cost of Rs. 2,19,040/-

Chief Minister's Merit Award

To encourage high scorers in the Higher Secondary Public Examination first 1000 boys and 1000 girls belonging to Adi Dravidar, Tribal and Adi Dravidar converted to Christianity who continue their further studies, are selected and a sum of Rs.1500/- p.a. is sanctioned as award for 5 years. The District Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare Officers have been delegated powers to sanction the Chief Minister's Merit Award. This amount is enhanced from Rs.1500/- to Rs.3000/- vide G.O.Ms.No.122, Adi Dravidar & Tribal Welfare Department, Dated 02.12.2011 from the financial year2012-13.
